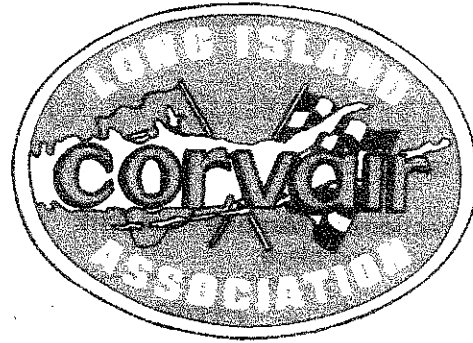
Aside from that, I have a few updates to share...

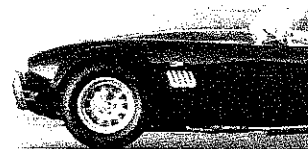

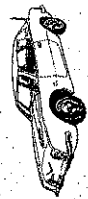


# 47th Annual Spring Meet

Each vehicle must have its own Fire Extinguisher.

Completed judging forms are the property of the GNYR. Trophies for 20 plus classes, 1st, 2nd and 3rd per class, plus Memorial Awards will be presented. No BBQ or fires. No loud music. No tents or canopies shall impede vehicle lanes.

#### From the West

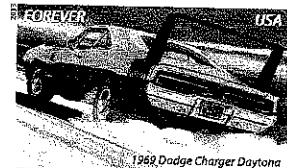
LIE exit 44 south to rte135
