
Newsletter editor's note


Vic also told us about Bill and his trip to Watkins Glenn in the Fingerlakes region by Seneca Lake.


Treasurer, Al Goldberg reported \$3,220.10 as of 9/11/14.



New 61-69 Fuel pump for sale


I carried this pump as my spare, but I now run an electric pump with a pass true cartridge in the stock housing.


