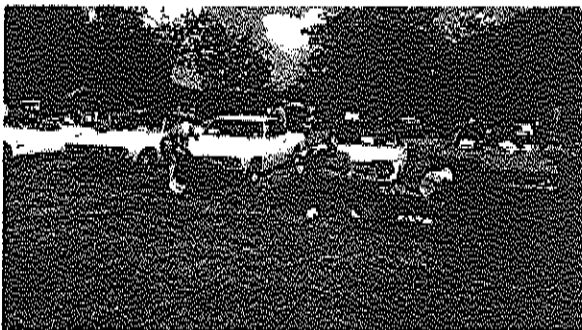
### Newsletter editor's note

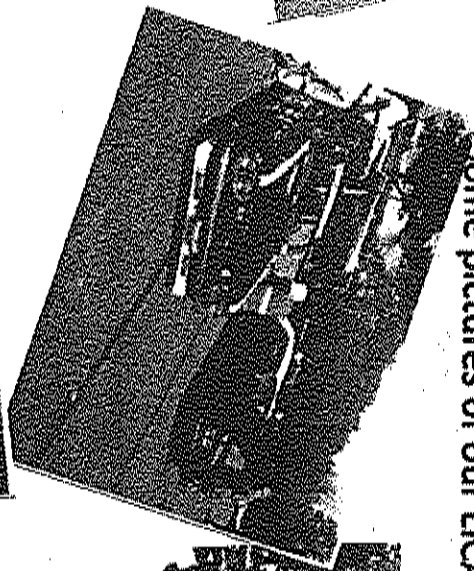
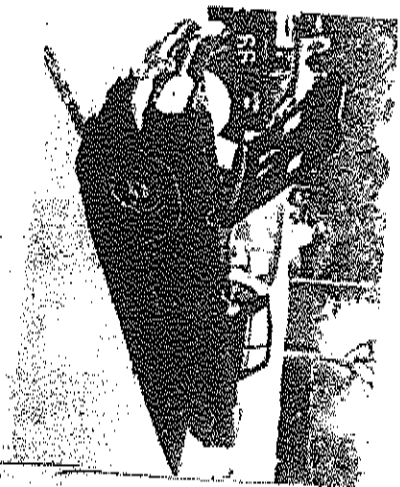
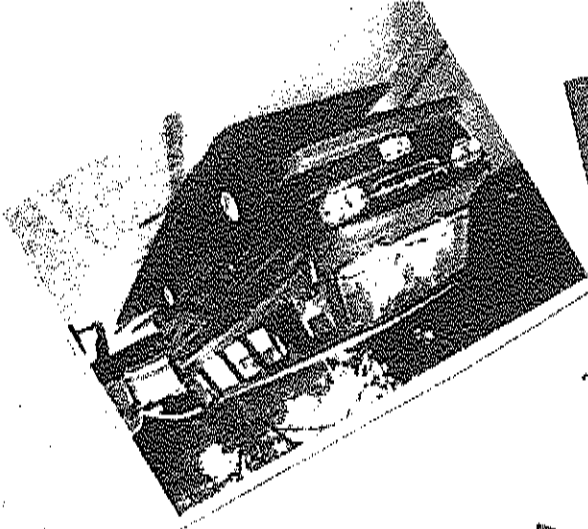
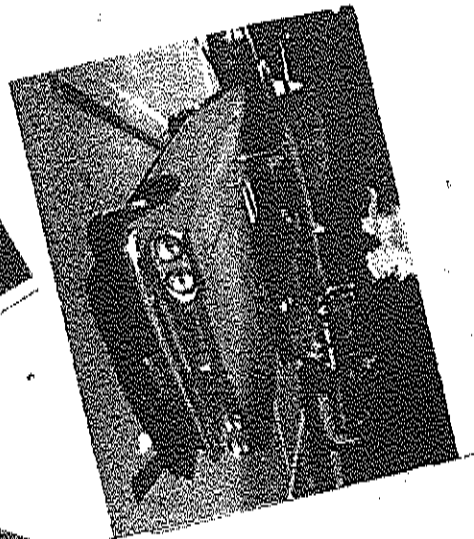
Vic also told us about Bill and his trip to Watkins Glenn in the Fingerlakes region by Seneca Lake.

I carried this pump as my spare, but I now run an electric pump with a pass true cartridge in the stock housing.

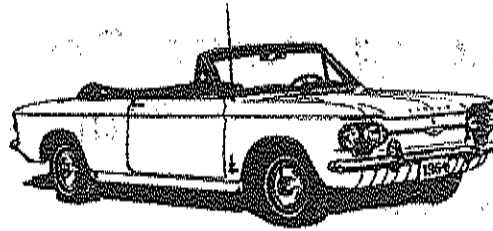
This is a new, never installed. Clark's unit for 1961 to 1969 engines. Clark has them for about \$60 + shipping now. How does \$40 sound ?

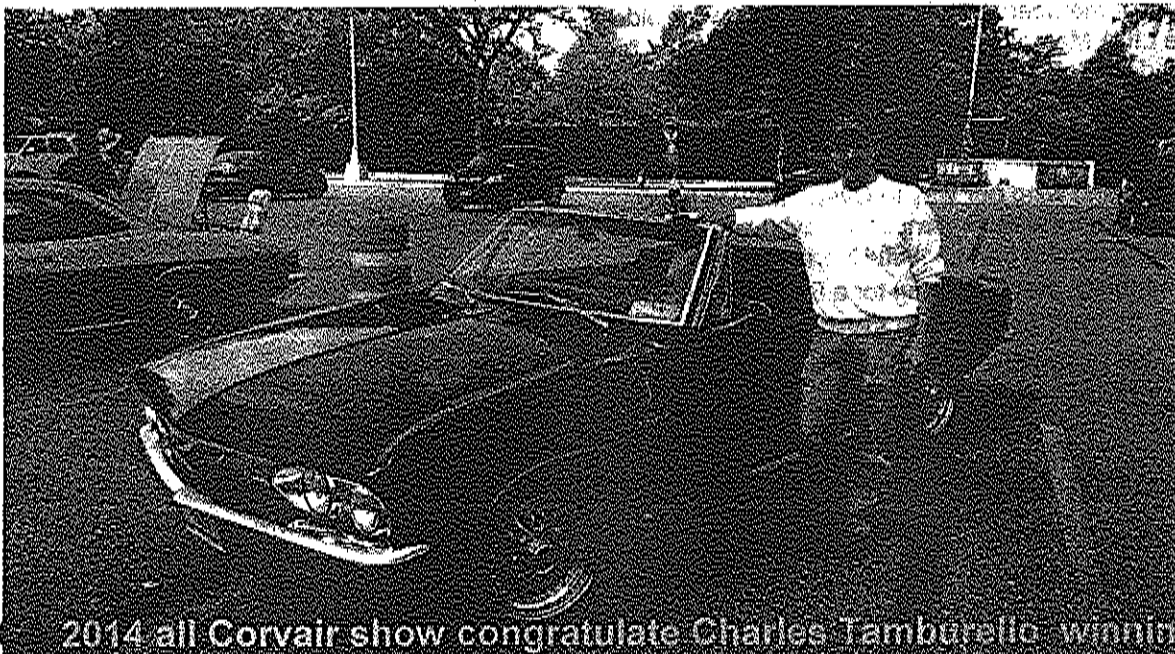
#### From the West
